Canadian Aid for Chernobyl Responsibilities

Application Process

- To check references and do an “in home interview” with potential host families
- To check potential and existing host families through CPIC and Children & Family Services
- To acknowledge the receipt of complete application packages for potential and existing host families
- To complete all host family checks and inform families as accepted or declined by March 1, 2018

Travel

- To provide transportation for children and interpreters to and from Canada
- To provide Health Insurance for children and interpreters while in Canada
- To arrange the best possible airfare and travel routes for the children and interpreters
- To provide arrival and departure information, including luggage allowances

Summer Visits

- To provide host families with an address and telephone list of all host families
- To provide billeting of interpreters
- To provide host families with a calendar of events for summer activities
- To provide all new host families with a copy of the “Host Family Guide”
- To assign all host families an interpreter, their contact information, and a back-up

Host Family Responsibilities

Fundraising

- Host families must EITHER participate in a minimum of two (2) CAC fund raising activities OR pay \$500 towards the children’s airfare.

Interpreters

- To understand that the interpreters are the legal guardians of all visiting children. They are responsible for the safety and care of the children and can be seriously reprimanded in Belarus if a child’s safety is questioned

Summer Visit

- To provide a healthy, loving, supportive home for the Belarusian child
- To provide any clothing (new or gently used) for the Belarusian child
- To book dental appointments for the child with donor dentists
- To book medical appointments for the child with donor doctors (if required)
- To provide transportation to and from appointments for their child and interpreter
- To participate in as many children’s summer group activities as possible
- To be a member in good standing of Canadian Aid for Chernobyl
